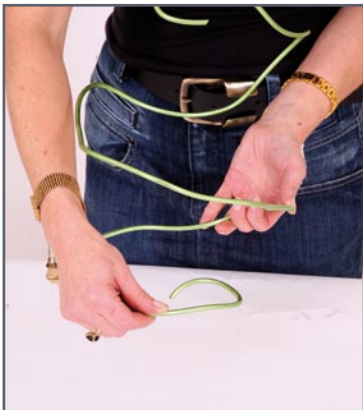
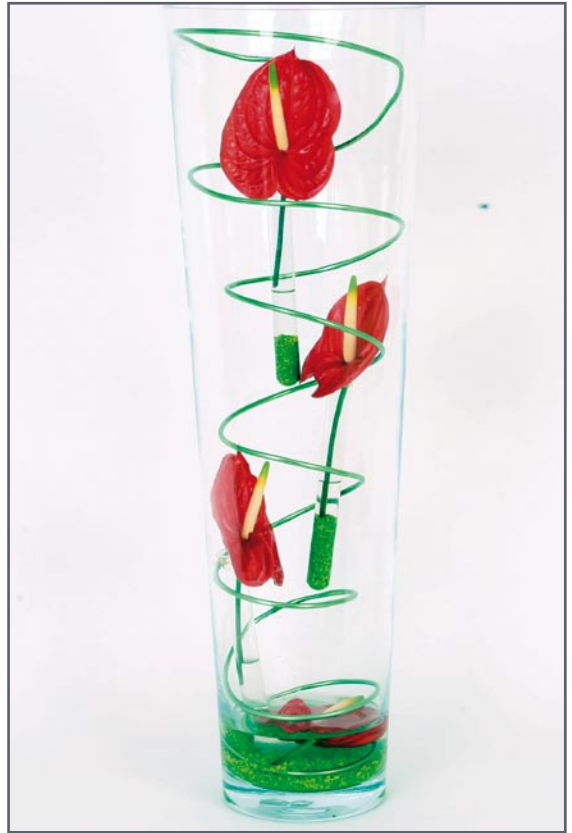


# Curly Wurly

With the nights drawing in and temperatures dropping, autumn is a great time to be bold and bright whilst everyone else is toning things down with the traditional autumn colours. This design, by Anita Jones from the Alexandra Lyons shop in Loughton, Essex, is the perfect example of how to keep things bright and buzzy, with corporate clients absolutely loving the style. If you want to stand out from the crowd in the competitive contract marketplace, this is how to do it!

## Ingredients:

Tall glass vase, glass test tubes, green gravel, green aluminium wire, gold decorative wire, scarlet Anthuriums.



**Step 1** Start by winding the aluminium wire to shape to form the spiral in the vase. A handy tip here is to wind it around another, smaller vase to create the shape.



**Step 2** Continue by attaching the test tubes to the aluminium wire. Use a decorative wire or similar for this, ensuring they're firmly attached.



**Step 3** Insert the wire into the vase, securing in place with the decorative gravel. Fill the test tubes with a bit more gravel and add the Anthuriums. Experiment with different colours and flowers to suit your customer tastes.
